### Publication of the Conference proceeding

Conference proceedings will be publish in two forms:

- in printed form;
- in electronic form.

Proceedings for publication **in printed form** should not exceed 2 pages of the text in Word format (font Times New Roman, usual, 12 p., interval 1.15), including full name of the author (-s), name of the organization (-s) and e-mail (-s). It should be applied the proceeding annotation (not more than 10 lines) *NECESSARILY*.

Representation of the proceeding for the publication in printed form is *OBLIGATORY*.

Deadline of representation of the proceedings for the publication in printed form is June,  $1^{th}$ , 2010.

Proceedings for publication **in electronic form** should be issued according to following rules:

- proceedings should not exceed 10 pages of the text in Word format, pages are not numbered;
  - font Times New Roman, usual, 12 p., interval 1.15;
  - fields of page are 2.0 from each sides;
  - order of the text arrangement and the font size:
    - 1<sup>st</sup> line: name of proceeding, arrangement on the center, arrangement on the center, font capital, bold, size 14 p.;
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> line: author (-s) full name (-s), arrangement on the center, font capital, bold, italic, size 12 p.;
    - 3<sup>rd</sup> line: organization name (-s) and e-mail (-s), arrangement on the center, font bold, size 12 p.;
  - tables and pictures should be included to text of the proceeding;
  - it is necessary to mark the literature references in the text of the proceeding in square brackets as a number from the list made alphabetically in the end of the proceeding.

Inclusion of pictures to the electronic version of the proceeding is welcomed!

Representation of the proceedings for the publication in electronic form is *NOT OBLIGATORY*, but *DESIRABLE*. The publication will be carried out on CD/DVD and distributed only among the Conference participants with observance of copyrights.

Deadline of representation of the proceedings for the publication in electronic form is July,  $1^{st}$ , 2010.

The Conference Organizing Committee undoubtedly considers opinion and desire of the author (-s), but reserves the right to itself to reject the proceedings or to recommend its form with the obligatory preliminary notice of the author (-s) till June, 15<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

The presented proceedings should be declared on the Conference ONLY through an official Conference web-site: www.seacoasts.ru, through your registration page, on the reference "Edit" of Your corresponding report.

Attention!!! For the organization of the Conference it is necessary to have preliminary booking. However in case of absence of the booking information from you before the marked deadline, the Conference Organizing Committee does not guarantee your accommodation in Hotel GELIOS for the period of the Conference.

#### Visa support

To start the procedure to obtain the Russian visa you should forward the filled registration form (ALL points, in English) and the scan-copy of your passport first page (with photo and information, 150 dpi resolution is optimal) **ONLY** by official Conference web-site: www.seacoasts.ru, through your registration page, before July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

Note that your passport should be valid for 6 months after the trip termination, i.e. till April, 2011. Organizing Committee will arrange an official invitation which will be sent to you and has to be used as attachment to your personal visa application to Russian Consulate in your country.

## Transfer of Conference participants
