1st Circular

General Information

On behalf of the «Sea Coasts» Working Group of the RAS Council on World Ocean and the Russian State Hydrometeorological University (RSHU), the Organizing Committee would like to welcome you and your colleagues to XXIII International Coastal Conference «Coastal Evolution Studies: Traditions and Modern Concepts» devoted to the 100th anniversary of Prof. Vsevolod Zenkovich – the founder of the Russian scientific coastal school. The purpose of the Conference is to bring together national and international researchers for exchange of experience and ideas to ensure further progress in

The participation of Prof. V. Zenkovich's scholars, their followers and other experts in the conference will contribute to the sharing of the up-to-date information on coastal processes.

Main topics of the Conference

- 1. Traditional and new studies on hydro-, morpho- and lithodynamics of the coastal zone;
- 2. Coastal zone ecology, integrative aspects in coastal studies;
- 3. Hydraulic engineering structures in the coastal zone of seas and natural and man-made lakes;
- 4. Principles of sustainable development and new technologies in coastal studies.

Languages

The official languages of the Conference are Russian and English.

Location and dates

The conference will take place on October 5-9, 2010 in Zelenogorsk town, the suburb of St. Petersburg, in the Hotel GELIOS situated on the seashore of the Gulf of Finland (30 minutes by car or 50 minutes by public transport from St. Petersburg). Participants will be accommodated at the same hotel.

Weather

The marine climate of St. Petersburg is characterized by relatively high air humidity, frequent cyclones and air masses brought from the Atlantic. The weather is changeable. Rainy days may occur. During the Conference, according to the mean annual data, the temperature of +6.6 °C (average maximum +9.5 °C and average minimum +4.7 °C); clouds 7 points (on 10-points scale) is expected.

Registration

The Conference desk will be open on October, 5 (evening) till October, 6 (morning) in the Hotel GELIOS.

Participants who wants to live in another hotel are kindly asked to make their registration by themselves.

Transfer of Conference participants

Free of charge buses St. Petersburg – Zelenogorsk (morning) and Zelenogorsk – St. Petersburg (evening) will be available for the participants during the Conference.

Visa support

To start the procedure to obtain the Russian visa you should forward the filled registration form (ALL points, in English) and the scan-copy of your passport first page (with photo and information, 150 dpi resolution is optimal) by e-mail to the Organizing Committee before July 1, 2010. Note that your passport should be valid for 6 months after the trip termination, i.e. till April, 2011. Organizing Committee will arrange an official invitation which will be sent to you and has to be used as attachment to your personal visa application to Russian Consulate in your country.

Excursion program

A field trip along the coasts of the Gulf of Finland including the visits the recreational zones and hydraulic engineering structures will take place on October 9, 2010. Some additional excursion will be possible during the Conference.
